A new law has taken effect to protect children from abuse and neglect, and support their right to safety, shelter, health care and education (The National, 15 June, 2016).

For the first time, anyone in contact with a child – from parents and teachers to doctors and nurses – can be held accountable for causing harm, and is legally obliged to report cases of suspected abuse (The National, 15 June, 2016).

Sheikh Zayed Private Academy for Boys recognizes that every student has the right to protection from abuse and exploitation and the right to have enquiries made to safeguard his or her welfare. The school places great importance on students' health, safety and welfare and aims to provide a caring, supportive and safe environment in which all our students can learn and develop to their full potential.
